We are writing this letter to offer our unreserved recommendation for the Architectural Consulting Group LLC, Inc. (ACG) as an Owner's Project Manager. As you may know, as Designer's we are not in control or even advisory on the selection of Owner's Project Manager. Yet, we could not have been more fortunate with the Building Committee's selection of ACG for the \$3.75M East Bridgewater Senior Center project (known locally as the Center at Sachem Rock). ACG, and Principal's Michael Josefek and Peter Koczera proved to be true team players throughout the design process and in bringing this project to successful completion.

As a renovation / addition to a historic building on a National Register Historic site, there were many challenges on this project both in design and construction. ACG was thoughtful and offered the utmost professional critique of our design work and brought helpful recommendations to the Building Committee, balancing both the requirements for economy and historic sensitivity. Clearly Principal Michael Josefek's background in architectural design lends itself well to this task.

They were early to point out concerns with the contractors scheduling, and kept this issue in the forefront of the Building Committee and Design Team consciousness, pressing upon us to meet our contract commitments in a timely manner and within the requirements of the contract so to avoid delay claims by the contractor.
